David Burndred (UK)

David joined the Audit and Risk Committee in December 2024 and brings extensive international financial leadership experience to the role together with a strong track record in developing value-add risk management frameworks.

David is currently Senior Advisor at Better Society Capital, a leading UK social impact investment institution, having previously been their Chief Financial Officer for seven years. As CFO David collaborated closely with the BSC Audit & Risk Committee on a range of financial, operational and risk matters.

Earlier in his career David spent nine years at Commonwealth Development Corporation (now known as British International Investment), as an Investment Manager based in Africa and UK, growing and managing a portfolio of impact investments. He has also held senior international financial leadership roles in the professional services sector and with a FTSE250 technology business. David qualified as a Chartered Accountant with PWC.

David also currently holds voluntary sector governance roles at St Paul's Cathedral, London and the international microfinance charity Opportunity International UK.
