Commonwealth Day 2021

Commonwealth Day is an annual celebration observed across the 54 member countries. This year it will take place **virtually on 8 March 2021**, under the theme 'Delivering a Common Future: Connecting, Innovating, Transforming'. It is an opportunity for individuals, communities and organisations to promote the Commonwealth's shared values of peace, democracy and equality, and celebrate the association's rich diversity. COVID-19 means activities will largely take place virtually this year.

Let's celebrate Commonwealth Day

We would be honoured if you are able to celebrate Commonwealth Day and women's leadership with us, by kindly supporting one or more of the following actions.

1. Submit a woman leadership video

- Record a 30-60 second video message wherein you name a woman leader who has personally inspired you in your life or during COVID-19 and explain why – anyone from teachers and doctors to ministers and mothers. See 'video guidance' below, for video recording tips.
- On or before 8 March, **publish your video** on social media, with the hashtag **#SheLeadsTheWay**, alongside **#CommonwealthDay** and **#IWD2021**. Please also nominate others to join in by tagging them in your post. If room, also include our accounts **@CommonwealthSec** **@PScotlandCSG**.





2. Publish a Commonwealth Day message on social media

Video guidance

How to record

- **Film in landscape:** film the video horizontally.
- **Centre yourself in the middle of the shot:** ensure there is space on either side of you and there is space above your head.
- **Keep the video to under one minute:**
this allows use on social media.
- **Appropriate location:** choose a solid background (white preferably), no clutter or personal items in the frame.
- **Speak clearly and at a normal pace:**
check there is no echo, outside noise.
- **Check your lighting:** ensure you are not backlit, there is enough light to clearly see your face and wear solid clothing.
- **Record a test video:** recording a test video will help you ensure all of the guidance is followed and the video looks and sounds good.

What to say

- **Name a woman who has inspired you:** from teachers and doctors to ministers and mothers, this could be a woman either in your life or during COVID-19 who has inspired you for good. Explain briefly why, using a heart-warming story or a positive life outlook she has given you, for example.
- **Invite others to join in:** encourage your audience to do the same as you, mentioning the use of hashtag **#SheLeadsTheWay** and Commonwealth Secretariat if possible.
- **You could say:** "Now I invite you to name a woman who has inspired you in your life or during COVID-19. Don't forget to use hashtag **#SheLeadsTheWay** when you share your video, and follow Commonwealth Secretariat to see more inspirational videos. Let's reframe what it means to be a leader in our communities during COVID-19 and beyond, to help inspire an equal future for everyone."

Key messages

Feel free to craft your own social media posts from the below key messages and facts.

- The Commonwealth is a family built around our shared values and history. We have a shared ambition and vision for a more prosperous and equal world; we collaborate for a common good and are committed to our strategic objectives and the achievement of the SDGs.
 - COVID-19 has challenged all Commonwealth countries, but we remain hopeful that we will emerge stronger and more committed to our values than before. In 2020 we have achieved progress in tackling climate change, strengthening democracy, protecting our oceans and supporting gender equality.
 - In 2021, the Commonwealth will strive for connection, transformation, innovation and a renewed vision for a world that delivers a common future and serves a common good.
 - Young people (over one billion in the Commonwealth) give us hope and will help us deliver our promise of a better world.
 - The International Women's Day 2021 theme offers us a great opportunity to celebrate women in our communities who are providing leadership in the time of Covid-19.
- Across every sphere, from health to the economy, security to social protection, the impacts of COVID-19 are exacerbated for women and girls simply by virtue of their sex.
 - Women tend to earn less and have fewer savings.
 - Women work more in the informal economy and have less access to social protections.
 - Women are more likely to be burdened with unpaid care and domestic work, and therefore have to drop out of the labour force.
 - Women make up the majority of single-parent households.
 - #SheLeadsTheWay is a great opportunity to celebrate women in our communities who are providing leadership in the time of Covid-19. It is an opportunity for people to nominate a woman in their community who has shown leadership during Covid-19 or in their lives.
