Second Commonwealth Sustainable Energy Forum

12–14 May 2021

The Commonwealth recognises the critical importance of sustainable energy to economic development and the imperative to transition to clean forms of energy. This aligns with commitments made by governments under the Paris Agreement on climate change, while acknowledging that an inclusive global economic recovery requires a renewed commitment to the sustainable use of natural resources.

The second Commonwealth Sustainable Energy Forum on 12–14 May 2021 aims to facilitate consensus building, knowledge sharing as well as raised ambitions amongst member countries, through a series of roundtable discussions. It will also provide an opportunity to discuss new possibilities for accelerating the implementation of nationally determined contributions (NDCs) under the Paris Agreement and country-wide strategies for the achievement of SDG7.
