
2nd Open Ended Working Group Meeting on Model Indicators on Sport, PE, Physical Activity and the SDGs

20th November 2019, International Labour Organization, Geneva, Switzerland

Overview

The **2nd Open Ended Working Group Meeting on Model Indicators on Sport and the SDGs** will be held at the International Labour Organization (ILO) headquarters in Geneva on **November 20th 2019**. The event will be delivered by the Commonwealth Secretariat working with UNESCO and the ILO as meeting hosts.

The meeting will focus on reviewing an updated measurement framework and indicators on sport, physical education, physical activity and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), sharing key learning and practical guidance emanating from pilot projects and identifying opportunities to engage additional stakeholders in this initiative.

Background

A three-year project was initiated in July 2017 to develop, test and validate a measurement framework and model indicators to support member countries, sporting bodies and other stakeholders to measure, evaluate and enhance the contribution of sport, physical education and physical activity to prioritised SDGs and targets.

This initiative delivers on Action 2 of the Kazan Action Plan, adopted by the Sixth International Conference of Ministers and Senior Officials Responsible for Physical Education and Sport (MINEPS VI) and endorsed by the UNESCO General Conference, and a direct request of the 9th Commonwealth Sports Ministers Meeting. It has also been aligned and coordinated with the UN Action Plan on Sport for Development and Peace 2018 to 2020, which includes as Action Area 4 a focus on improving sport-related data, and the World Health Organisation's Global Action Plan on Physical Activity.

An Open Ended Working Group structure has been established to advance this collaborative international initiative allowing diverse stakeholders to contribute to the iterative development and scaled utilisation of common global indicators on the contribution of sport, physical education and physical activity to the SDGs.

The 2nd Open Ended Working Group meeting is being coordinated with the Sporting Chance Forum, which will be held at the Palais de Nations in Geneva from 21st to 22nd November, allowing some participants to attend both events.
