- "The purpose of this paper is to discover, discuss and evaluate Ghana's water laws as discoverable through customary practices, the common law and the statutes." (from the Introduction).

The major laws, including Customary Law, Common Law and Statutory Law, are evaluated as follows:

The Rivers Ordinance 1903, No.2, examines dredging of rivers, diverting rivers and navigation of steam vessels.

The Volta River Development Act, 1961, No.46, discusses electricity generation,

dam control, the development of the lake as a source of fish, the health and well-being of inhabitants (including biological control of parasites and water and sewerage), river transport and the Volta River Authority.

The Ghana Water and Sewerage Corporation Act, 1965, No.310 and the Oil in Navigable Waters Act, 1964, No.235 are considered.

The Environmental Protection Council Decree, 1974, NRCD 239, discusses the coordination of activities having environmental impact, educational and research activities, and law making and enforcement. This is not purely a water law but the water content has been picked out.

Some consideration is given to the laws which have less relevance to water: the Forests Ordinance, 1951 (revised), Cap.157, the Mosquitoes Ordinance, 1951 (revised), Cap.75, and the Wild Animals Preservation Act, 1961, Act 43.

He concludes that Ghana's water laws "show reasonable concern about water use" although this concern has taken a long time to be realised in legislation.

Rouse Jones outlines three problems which arose in the legal negotiations of the Volta River Project, which he discusses in turn:

- "1. That one of the two main parties was the government of the country where the development was to take place.
2. That the other main party was a company owned by interests outside the territory of the government of the country. This factor is not an aspect of the first-mentioned factor, but is entirely different. Bound up with this consideration, however, is the fact that the second-mentioned main party was a company with limited liability.
3. The great cost of the Project in terms of money."

He makes no attempt to consider problems relating to water supply and control or water quality.
